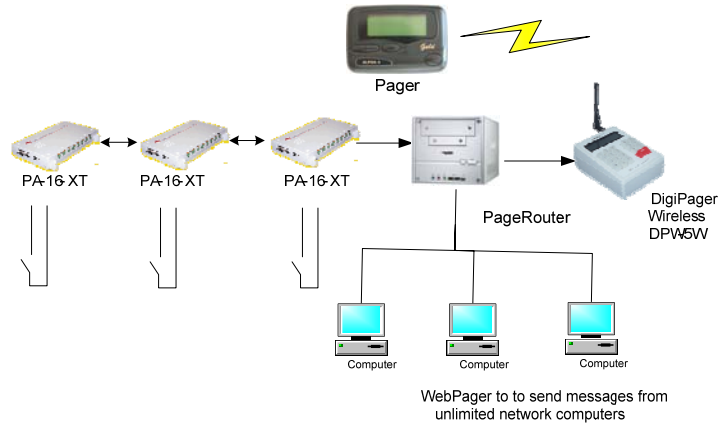

PageRouter Pro software is a powerful and reliable tool to monitor contacts using PageAlert Modules.



In addition to standard PageAlert functions, you can benefit from additional functionality:

- **PageRouter Pro** allows you to quickly change **PageAlert** canned messages and message destination assignment with drag-and-drop action.
- Program **escalation** to send the alarm message to an alternate individual or Group, if contact does not change status within a programmable period.
- Program specific **monitoring date and time** per contact. *i.e.: Monitor back exit door between 5 PM and 3 AM.*
- Program **"Time Shifts"** to be assigned to users and Groups. Change users in Groups, at anytime, following work schedules. *i.e.: Contact 3 should page staff in the Night Shift group between 6 PM and 2 AM and in the Day Shift group between 8 AM and 4 PM.*
- Provide access to authorized personnel to **send messages from any network computer** using a browser.
- Authorized personnel can **view the log of alarm and regular messages** for their Department on any network computer.
- Use "maps" with **"drag-and-drop"** action to program users in Groups and Departments, program Time Shift assignment, and contacts assignments including escalation.



PageRouter gives the Administrator **complete programming flexibility** to change canned alarm messages, destination of messages, time shifts, people in Groups, and all monitoring parameters on the PageRouter computer.

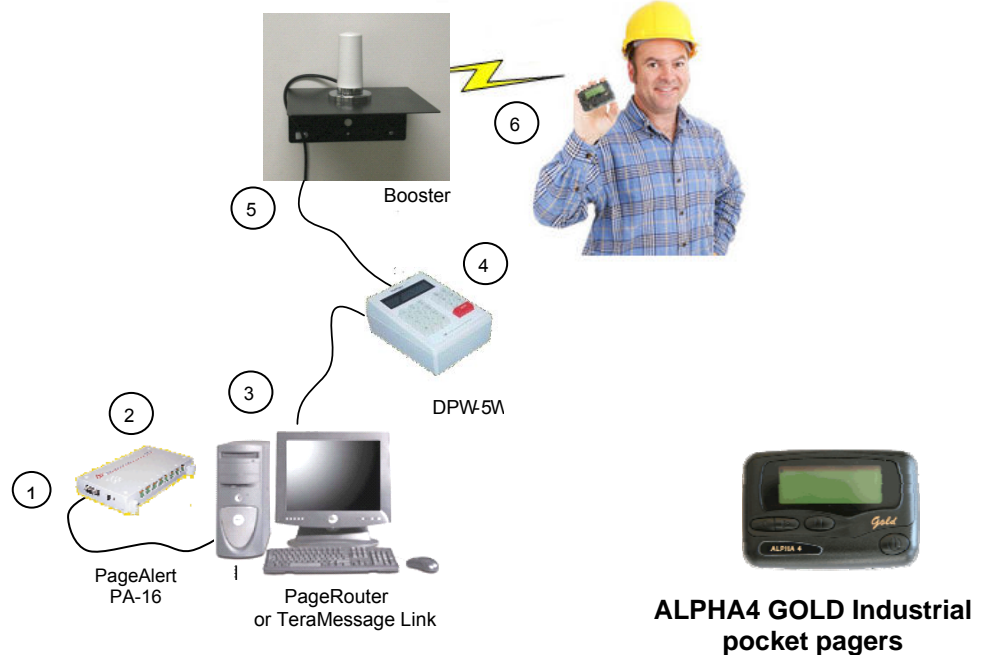

Installation example of PageRouter Pro with PageAlert Modules



- 1 Run a twisted pair cable from each PageAlert contact monitor to each relay contact.
- 2 Connect the PA-16 module to a serial port of the PageRouter Pro computer using a 6 ft. RS-232 cable. You can extend the cable length by using RJ-45 to 9-pin D adaptors and up to 1,000 ft. of CAT5/CAT6 cable with RJ-45 connectors.
- 3 In PageRouter, for each contact, program a canned message, the recipient and select transmission on contact close, open, or both. Optionally, program repeats, escalation and response delays. Program users, Groups, Departments and Time Shifts.
- 4 Connect the DigiPager paging transmitter to a serial port of the PageRouter computer using a 6 ft cable. You can extend the cable length by using RJ-45 to 9-pin D adaptors and up to 1,000 ft. of CAT5/CAT6 cable with RJ-45 connectors.
- 5 Install the wall mount antenna. Connect the antenna to the DigiPager transmitter.
- 6 Alarm and typed messages are received in one or all the pagers, within a few seconds.

PageRouter Pro offers multiple options that can be added at any time. For example, it can send alarm messages to Blackberrys and other Smartphones; receive plain ASCII messages from existing Alarm systems; and many other optional capabilities. Please contact us for specific applications.
