SENDING EMERGENCY MESSAGES

From Touch-Tone Telephones

During an emergency, when time is of essence, use any land or cellular telephone inside or outside the building to quickly send a message asking for help. Trained staff can send specific instructions by triggering canned messages stored in the system.

From Network Computers

PageRouter allows your staff to use any computer in the network to quickly send messages.

In case of an emergency, paging from any computer may prove to be vital. With PageRouter, you can page from any computer even if it has never been used before to page messages. Simply use any browser to access PageRouter.

From Stand-alone Keyboard Devices

Canamex Communications manufactures QUIKPAGER 2400 stand-alone devices to page text messages without depending on your network. This is an excellent option to continue paging if your network collapses during an emergency situation stopping access to PageRouter from network computers.

From the Internet

This is an important option that allows you and your team to page staff from outside the building. Think of a situation that required evacuation of your building. You could actually page your staff from a laptop or your neighbor's computer by connecting to your PageRouter via the Internet. This feature can be used by 911 and other Emergency Dispatch Centers in case of a regional disaster.

DESTINATION OF MESSAGES

PageRouter offers optional destinations of messages. You can send a message to one or a group of people at the same and to different destinations.

On-Site

PageRouter delivers messages to staff with alphanumeric pagers in your building in **a few seconds**. Canamex paging encoders and transmitters can be configured to cover one building, the campus or a surrounding area from 1 to 25 miles in radius depending on the terrain and your needs.

Commercial Devices

PageRouter can send messages to people with commercial alphanumeric pagers and cellular telephones. PageRouter can optionally deliver messages to commercial carriers using a dialup or an Internet connection.

Two-Way Radios

PageRouter can convert text to voice for transmission to two-way radios used by security and emergency personnel. Imagine a situation where your security staff can quickly receive specific emergency messages and be the first to act.

Email Addresses

PageRouter can send emergency messages to email address for notification of specific events.

Remote PageRouter Systems

Depending on the size of your company or institution, you may have other PageRouters installed in remote buildings. This option allows PageRouter systems to exchange messages and serve as



backup in case of disaster events such as earthquakes, fires, flooding, tornados, etc., where buildings are damaged or evacuated.

HARDWARE OPTIONS

Choosing the correct Canamex hardware for a PageRouter messaging system is important.

Sentinel Controller and Monitor

When on-site paging is critical, such as code blue and staff-to-staff messages in a Hospital, consider the use of the Sentinel monitor to ensure 100% on-site transmission reliability.

PageRouter Server

Canamex Communications offers server computers configured with the level of reliability needed for your application. Servers may have RAID 1 to RAID 5 for manual or hot swap

of hard drives. We will configure the computer PageRouter Server to your specific requirements.

Power Backup for your PageRouter system

The PageRouter Server must be connected to an Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) to provide operation in case of a main power failure.

Connect your network devices to ensure PageRouter connectivity to the Internet or to your external network in case of a power failure in your building.

Ensure that the telephone lines connected to PageRouter also operate in case of a main power failure.
